An educational fall tillage demonstration on Dec 13 to compare the features and benefits the station has observed using it's one-pass tillage implement as compared to multi-pass operations. Our implement was made possible by contributions from the NC Cotton Producers Association. Preliminary observations indicate it is not for cotton only. One of our local equipment companies is going to furnish a tractor equipped with GPS guidance and technologies to demonstrate the benefits to attendees. All field demonstrations are going to be on the north side of the station. Dr. Keith Edmisten and Todd Spivey, Graduate Assistant, will also be available to discuss ongoing tillage trials on the south side for those interested.
